

After this manner, therefore pray ye...

Adapted from prayers/promises of Jesus, Jabez, Moses, David, Solomon, Isaiah, Ezekiel, Joel, Peter, Paul, John.
Ps 5:3 My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.

1. **Worship God for who He is:**

- Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. (Matt 6:9)
- He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (Ps 91:1)
- Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created. (Rev 4:11)
- That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; (Phil 2:10)
- Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of his holiness. (Ps 48:1)

2. **Revival, soul winning, kingdom influence, expanse, and preparedness:**

- Thy kingdom come (Matt 6:10)
- Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: (Luke 12:37)
- I must be about My Father's business. (Luke 2:49)
- Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest. (Matt 9:38)
- Enlarge my coast (1 Chron 4:10)
- But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses (Acts 1:8)
- For the promise is unto you, and to your children (Acts 2:39)

3. **Direction in general:**

- Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven (Matt 6:10)
- Shew me thy ways, O Lord; teach me thy paths. (Ps 25:4)
- That thine hand might be with me (1 Chron 4:10)
- Not my will, but thine, be done. (Luke 22:42)
- Neither know we what to do but our eyes are upon thee. (2 Chron 20:12)
- Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. (Prov 3:5-6)
- The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way. (Ps 37:23)

a. *direction as a person/individual-*

- Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee. (Ps 143:8)
- And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left. (Isa 30:21)

b. *direction as a partner-*

- Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it (Eph 5:25).
- Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered. (1 Pet 3:7)
- That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands (Titus 2:4).
- Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. (Eph 5:22)

c. *direction as a parent-*

- I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth. (3 John 4).
- And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. (Eph 6:4)

- That they may teach the young women to... love their children (Titus 2:4)
- d. *direction as a professional/citizen-*
- Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men. (Prov 22:29)
- Whoso keepeth the fig tree shall eat the fruit thereof: so he that waiteth on his master shall be honoured. (Prov 27:18)
- Servants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God: And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. (Col 3:22-24)
- I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. (1 Tim 2:1-2)

After this manner, therefore pray ye...

4. Provision:

- Give us this day our daily bread (Matt 6:11)
- Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed (1 Chron 4:10)
- Give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny thee, and say, Who is the LORD? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God in vain. (Prov 30:8-9)
- For the Lord thy God blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow (Deut 15:6)
- And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the

- palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you. (Joel 2:25)
- °But my God shall supply all your need (Phil 4:19)
- The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it. (Prov 10:22)
- He healeth all thy diseases (Ps 103:3)
- And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him. (1 John 5:14-15)

5. Pardon/Forgiveness:

- And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. (Matt 6:12)
- He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy. (Prov 28:13)
- If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)
- Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. (Ps 139:23-24)
- Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside (Deut 11:16)
- Who can understand his errors? cleanse thou me from secret faults. Keep back thy servant also from

- presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression. (Ps 19:12-13)
- Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. (Isa 1:18)
- the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. (1 John 1:7)
- To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. (2 Cor 5:19)
- Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. (Ps 51:10)

6. Protection:

- And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil (Matt 6:13)
- There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it. (1 Cor 10:13)
- That thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! (1 Chron 4:10)
- Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. (Luke 10:19)
- Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (James 4:7)
- Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities,

- against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (Eph 6:11-12)
- (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 2 Cor 10:4
- And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. (Rev 12:11)
- The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them. (Ps 34:7)
- For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. (Ps 91:11)
- Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation? (Heb 1:14)

7. Praise for what God has done:

- For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen (Matt 6:13)
- This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. (Ps 118:24)

- Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: (Ps 103:1-2)

8. Answer:

- And God granted him that which he requested. (1 Chron 4:10)

- If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. (John 14:14)
